ADDRESS/EMERGENCY SERVICES LOCATION SIGNS

Adams County Numbering ordinance #3-1997 requires all property owner/occupants to request an address/location number. The purpose of this ordinance was designed to enable “Emergency Service Personnel” to find your address/location as quickly as possible.

A well-maintained house identification system is vital for police, rescue squads, firemen and delivery firms to perform their jobs efficiently.

If you have moved your sign from the original installation **MOVE IT BACK**. If it is not moved back the Town of Monroe will move it to the original location and you will be charged the fee of \$50.00. If this fee is not paid the fee will be placed on the tax roll as a **special assessment**.

The Town of Monroe maintains a policy to **replace faded and damaged** address/location signs. Monroe Township requires a fee of \$50.00, payable in advance to cover the cost of manufacture and installation of sign which shape and design was standardized by the county. If this fee is not paid, the sign will be installed and the fee will be placed on the tax roll as a **special assessment**.

If your sign becomes covered with brush or is not able to be seen clearly, you must remove the brush or obstacle. If you do not, the Town of Monroe will remove the brush or obstacle and charge the landowner with the cost. If this fee is not paid, the sign will be installed and the fee will be placed on the tax roll as a **special assessment**.
